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ORDINANCE NO: 07-03
Liberty County, Florida

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING IN TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER COSTS, AN ADDITIONAL TWO DOLLARS TO BE USED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATION AND TRAINING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 318.18 (11)(d) establishes that an additional two dollars (\$2.00) may be assessed against every person in violation of a pedestrian infraction, a nonmoving traffic infraction and a moving traffic infraction; and

WHEREAS, the collection of the two dollars would be used in any or all permitted purposes set forth in Florida Statute 938.15, such as expenditures for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses, including basic recruit training for their respective officers and employing agency support personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Board has the authority to enact this Ordinance pursuant to Florida Statute 938.15 and Florida Statute 318.18(11)(d).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Liberty County Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, as follows:

1. An additional two dollars, in addition to all other costs, shall be collected as court costs against every person in violation of a pedestrian infraction, a nonmoving traffic infraction and a moving traffic infraction where said offense occurred within Liberty County.
2. The collection of the two dollars will be used for any and all permitted purposes as set forth in Florida Statute 938.15, such as expenditures for criminal justice education degree programs and training courses, including basic recruit training for their respective officers and employing agency support personnel.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
