

ORDINANCE NO. 24-1

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A NEW CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN; PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF AMENDING SUCH CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Liberty County Code consisting of two parts entitled "Code of Ordinances, Liberty County, Florida" and "Liberty County Land Development Code" published by Municode, consisting of chapters 1 through 30 and 101 through 113, each inclusive, respectively, is adopted.

Section 2. All ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before August 10, 2023, and not included in the Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are repealed.

Section 3. The repeal provided for in section 2 shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof that has been repealed by a subsequent ordinance that is repealed by this ordinance.

Section 4. Additions or amendments to the Code when passed in such form as to indicate the intention of the Board of County Commissioners to make the same a part of the Code shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Code, so that reference to the Code includes the additions and amendments.

Section 5. Ordinances adopted after August 10, 2023, that amend or refer to ordinances that have been codified in the Code shall be construed as if they amend or refer to like provisions of the Code.

Section 6. The Clerk of Court shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Department of State within ten days of its adoption. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Department of State.
