

ORDINANCE NO. 81-4

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING IN CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER COSTS, AN ADDITIONAL \$2.00 TO BE USED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATION AND TRAINING.

Section 1. There is hereby assessed by the County of Liberty in compliance with section 943.25(5), F.S., an additional two and No/100(\$2.00) dollars, as court costs against every person convicted for violation of a state penal or criminal statute or convicted of a municipal or county ordinance, where said offense occurred within the County of Liberty. However, no such assessment shall be made against any person convicted for violation of any state statute, municipal or county ordinance relating to the parking of vehicles.

All such assessments shall be collected by the appropriate court and shall be remitted to the County of Liberty and earmarked for law enforcement education and training for members of the Sheriff's Department. The use and expenditure of such funds shall be in accordance with education and training programs for law enforcement personnel as determined by the Sheriff and in accordance with section 943.14(4), F.S.

Section: This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
