

LIBERTY COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 89-01

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN 300 FEET OF A CHURCH HOUSE OR SCHOOL BUILDING; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell any alcoholic beverage within 300 feet of any Church House or School Building in Liberty County, Florida.

Section II. Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor in the second degree, punishable as provided by Section 775.082 and 775.083, Florida Statutes.

Section III. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage as provided by law.
