

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT FOR FEES FOR DISPOSAL OF WASTE MATERIALS AT THE LIBERTY COUNTY LANDFILL; ADOPTING RATE CATEGORIES AND AMOUNTS; PROVIDING FOR THOSE PERMITTED TO USE THE LAND FILL; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Liberty County operates a landfill for the disposal of certain types of solid waste materials; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, desires to establish a schedule of rates to be charged for the disposal of various types of solid waste at the Liberty County landfill, and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida desires to set qualifications for use of the landfill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, that:

SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT OF FEE.

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, there shall be charged an appropriate fee, in accordance with the schedule set out in Section 2 of this Ordinance, for the disposal of any solid waste material at the Liberty County landfill.

SECTION 2. SCHEDULE OF FEES.

The fees to be charged at the Liberty County landfill are as follows:

- A. Common automobile tires and light truck tires of similar size.....\$ 3.00 ea.
- B. Commercial tires (larger than common automobile tires) (without rims)..... 6.50 ea.
- C. Commercial tires (on rims)..... 35.00 ea.
- D. Off-road commercial tires..... 80.00 ea.
- E. All other material permitted to be disposed of at the landfill, including white goods and construction and demolition debris (as both terms are defined in Fla. Stat., Sec. 403.703)...(\$3.00 minimum).... 30.00 per ton

SECTION 3. QUALIFICATIONS FOR USE.

Only solid waste materials generated within Liberty County, Florida will be allowed to be placed in the Liberty County landfill.

SECTION 3. QUALIFICATIONS FOR USE.

Only solid waste materials generated within Liberty County, Florida will be allowed to be placed in the Liberty County landfill.

SECTION 4. CONFLICT.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

In accordance with Section 125.66, Florida Statutes, a certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Department of State by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners within ten (10) days after enactment, and this ordinance shall take effect upon receipt of official acknowledgement that said ordinance has been filed.

SECTION 7. PENALTY.

Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor in the second degree, punishable as provided by Section 775.082 and 775.083, Florida Statutes.
