ORDINANCE NO. 93-04

AN ORDINANCE OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 316.655(6), PROVIDING FOR AN ASSESSMENT OF A SURCHARGE OF TWELVE DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$12.50) FOR EACH MOVING TRAFFIC VIOLATION; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE SURCHARGE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Liberty County, Florida participates in an intergovernmental radio communication program approved by the Division of Communications of the Department of General Services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida finds it in the public interest of Liberty County to assess an additional surcharge of Twelve Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$12.50) for each moving traffic violation; and

WHEREAS, said surcharge shall be used by Liberty County, Florida to fund the County's participation in the program; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of Liberty County, Florida, has requested this Ordinance enacting said assessment;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LIBERTY COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to Chapter 125, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Pursuant to Florida Statute 316.655(6), the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, hereby assesses an additional surcharge of Twelve Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$12.50) for each moving traffic violation.

Section 3. The surcharge assessed by this Ordinance shall be used by Liberty County, Florida to fund the county's participation in the intergovernmental

radio communication program approved by the Division of Communications of the Department of General Services.

Section 4. Said surcharge shall be in addition to any other penalties or sanctions provided by law.

Section 5. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

The foregoing Ordinance was adopted by a vote of 5 to 0 by the Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, after due notice and publication, upon motion, second and discussion in the regular meeting of September, 9th, 1993.
