Liberty County, Florida

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LIBERTY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVING A DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES THROUGH WAKULLA BANK; DESIGNATING AN APPROPRIATE OFFICIAL OF THE COUNTY TO APPROVE AND ADMINISTER THE DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Liberty County Board of County Commissioners has the authority to approve a deferred compensation program for county employees through Florida Statute 112.215; and

WHEREAS, the Board has previously approved and provided access to a deferred compensation plan to county employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board has the ability to approve additional deferred compensation plans for county employees and believes it is in the best interest of county employees to have another deferred compensation plan from which to choose;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Liberty County Board of County Commissioners of Liberty County, Florida, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Florida Statute 112.215, Robert Hill, the Clerk of Court for Liberty County, is designated as the appropriate official of Liberty County to approve and administer this deferred compensation plan. Robert Hill will be responsible for determining the deferred compensation plan's compliance with 112.215(6)(b).
2. Upon the satisfaction of Robert Hill, the Clerk of Court, the deferred compensation plan provided by Wakulla Bank will be available for county employees.
3. Any ongoing deferred compensation plan that has previously been approved by the Liberty County Board of County Commissioners remains in effect.
4. All prior ordinances or portions of ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed to have been repealed and are repealed to the extent of such conflict, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

5. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase or portion of this ordinance is held, for any reason to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.
6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
