ORDINANCE NO.: 2011-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LIBERTY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 86-04 AND 87-02 AND ANY OTHER COUNTY ORDINANCE PROVISIONS WHICH REGULATE FIREARMS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, House Bill Number 45 was recently enacted by the Florida Legislature; and

WHEREAS, House Bill Number 45 preempts the entire field of the regulation of firearms to the state and federal government; and


WHEREAS, the Liberty County Board of County Commissioners have two Ordinances that regulate the application and issuance of concealed weapons, to wit: Ordinance 86-04 and 87-02; and

WHEREAS, because House Bill Number 45 has been enacted recently, the Liberty County Board of County Commissioners desires to repeal any and all Ordinance provisions pertaining to the regulation of firearms, including specifically Ordinance Numbers 86-04 and 87-02.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LIBERTY COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FLORIDA THAT:

1. The Liberty County Board of County Commissioners hereby specifically repeals Ordinance Numbers 86-04 and 87-02 and also hereby repeals any and all other existing County Ordinance provisions that pertain to any regulation of firearms.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
