The Liberty County Board of County Commissioners will receive sealed bids from any qualified person, company or corporation interested in providing construction services for the following project:

### County Road 67 Indian Creek Bridge Repair

The project shall consist of the minor repairs to the CR 67 over Indian Creek Bridge #560012 in Liberty County, Florida.

Liquidated damages for failure to complete the project on the specified date will be set at \$200.00 per day.
